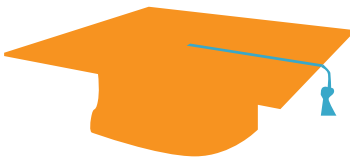

## What does this mean?

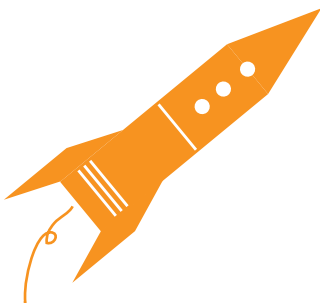
A person born in Greater Manchester can expect to live 76.8 years. While someone born in Surrey can expect to live to their 80's (81.1 years)... a difference of 4.3 years. This is because a person's life expectancy is linked to their income and wealth.
