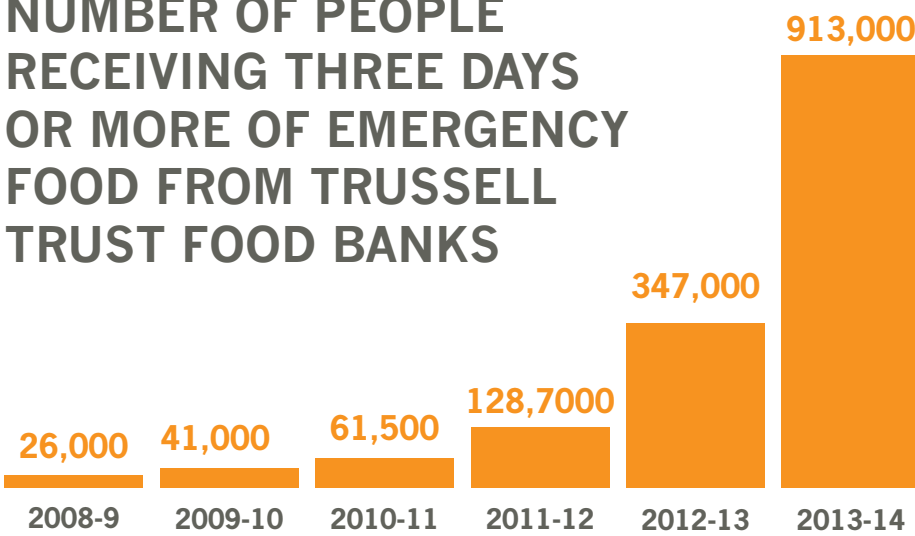


More and more people in the UK cannot afford to eat

What does this mean?

You might have thought that no-one in modern Britain would be starving in 2013, but in fact millions of people do not have enough to eat each day. As prices rise, people are spending much more on food - but eating less. The numbers who are relying on food banks to feed them are increasing, while more and more pupils are coming to school hungry. Household food bills are expected to increase by £357 by 2017.
